

Modern Slavery Act Policy 2016

As a company it is committed to the prevention of acts of modern day slavery from within its own business and that from within its supply chains. The company acknowledges its responsibility and obligations to the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and will ensure transparency within the organisation and with suppliers of goods and services to the company.


As part of the company's due diligence regarding slavery and human trafficking the company will not support or deal with any business knowingly involved in slavery or human trafficking and pledges to report any evidence of such to the appropriate authorities.

Hams Transport accepts responsibility for its staff in relation to this policy and staff are made aware of their responsibilities.

If anyone in the company has any concerns regarding a likely risk of, or actual breach of our policy or the legislation, they must bring it to the attention of the Managing Director at the earliest opportunity.

We will review this on an annual basis.
